- ◆ **Uichol Kim**, Ph.D., Professor, College of Business Administration, Inha University, Korea (2005-present). He has taught at the Department of Psychology, Chung-Ang University (1995-2005), Department of Social Psychology, University of Tokyo, Japan (1994) and Department of Psychology, University of Hawaii at Manoa, USA (1988-1994). He is an Honorary Professor, Gratia Christina College, Hong Kong, International Advisory Board Member of Business School, National Institute for Development Administration, Thailand, and Board Member of Bachelor of Human Sciences in Psychology Programme, International Islamic University and for Bachelor in

Community Empowerment, Universiti Malaysia Kelantan, Malaysia.

- ◆ He has taught at universities in Asia (Beijing Normal University, Xiamen University, China; Kurume University, Japan; Universitas Gadjah Mada and Universitas Udayana, Indonesia; University of Malaysia Perlis, Malaysia; National Institute of Developmental Administration and Kasem Bundit University, Thailand; University of Thailand Chamber of Commerce, Yangon, Myanmar), Europe (University of Stockholm, Sweden; Nordic Institute of Asian Studies, Denmark; University of Konstanz, Germany; Warsaw School of Advanced Social Psychology, Poland; University of Bergen and University of Tromsø, Norway).
- ◆ He was recognized as Outstanding Research Professor at Inha University (2011) and Chung-Ang University (2002). He has been recognized as the second most cited Social Scientist in Korea (2016). He has conducted research in indigenous, organizational and cultural psychology, focusing on family and parent-child relationship, education attainment and school violence, organizational culture and leadership, health and quality of life, democracy, human rights and political culture. In management, his research and teaching focus on leadership, organizational behavior and business ethics, and strategic and knowledge management, emphasizing creativity, innovation, entrepreneurship, leadership and sustainable development.
- ◆ He has published over 200 articles and 15 books and monographs, including Individualism and collectivism (Sage, 1994), Indigenous and cultural psychology (2006, Springer), Democracy, human right and Islam in modern Iran (with Shirin Ebadi, 2003 Nobel Laureate in Peace, Fagbokforlaget, 2003). He is one of the founders and served as president of Asian Association of Social Psychology, Asian Association of Indigenous and Cultural Psychology. He is the founding editor of *Asian Journal of Social Psychology* (SSCI listed journal).
- ◆ He provided lectures at leading institutions in the USA (Brown University, Columbia University, Georgetown University, Harvard University, Stanford University, Tufts University, Yale University), Europe (University of Rome, “La Sapienza,” Italy; L’École des hautes études en sciences sociales and Le Havre University, France; University of Osnabruck and German Institute for International Educational Research, Germany), the Middle East (Haifa University, Israel; Koc University, Turkey), and Asia (Chinese Academy of Sciences, China; Academia Sinica, National Taiwan University, and National Chengchi University, Taiwan; International Christian University and Kyoto University, Japan; Universitas Indonesia; University of the Philippines-Diliman, De La Salle University, Philippines).
